Author names are displayed in the form (and sequence) as they are submitted in the middle of page below the title, i.e.:

3. The abstract (Times New Roman 10. The word “**Abstract**” is bolded 10, but the text is not bold) (approximately 150 to 250 words).

Tip – Don’t include reference citations or undefined abbreviations in the abstract, since abstracts are often read independently of the actual chapter and without access to the reference list

4. Selecting the keywords (Times New Roman 10, Italic)

Select a phrase of 2-5 words that best describes the paper’s content in alphabetical order.

Keywords: *digital art, educational-edutainment systems, etc.*

5. Headings (Times New Roman 14, bold, sub-headings: Times New Roman 12, bold)

6. Content of papers (Times New Roman, 12, full justify, single line space) **6 pages maximum**

7. Emphasis and special type

Tip – Italics should be used for emphasized words or phrases in running text, but do not format entire paragraphs in italics.

8. No Footnotes (strictly) Please do not use footnotes for any reason; in case needed you may use endnotes instead. Endnotes should not contain figures, tables and/or the bibliographic details of a reference. Also, endnotes should not be used instead of a reference list.

9. Figures and Illustrations

Numbering – Please, number the figures and do not write “the following figure”.
