GUIDELINES FOR FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

The total length of the submitted paper should not exceed 6,000 words (preferably **between 3,500-6,000 words**).

ARRANGEMENT OF PAPER:

All Authors are asked to write *on the first page* of a paper:

- The name(s) of the author(s)
- The affiliation(s)
- The e-mail address

Papers should be typed in Times New Roman (12 pt.) with normal space.

STRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS:

Papers in English may be up to 6 - 12 pages including abstract up to 250 words and bibliography.

The paper should be typewritten in A4 format, set in one column according to the following parameters: margins – 2.5 cm, text editor – MS Word, Times New Roman, font number 12, spaces between lines – Single, layout – Justified. Each paragraph should start with a 1.5 cm indentation. Pages should be numbered and tables and pictures should be numbered and named (with captions). Tables and pictures must be cited in the text, e.g., (see Table 1); Arabic numbering should be used. The size of tables and pictures should not exceed A4 format page.

The paper should be submitted as a Microsoft Word or Open Office document, via EasyChair.

AT THE BEGINNING OF THE PAPER SHOULD BE MENTIONED:

Title of the paper (Times New Roman, 14 pt, bold, centred), **name(s)** of the author(s) (Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centred), institution, e-mail address (10 pt, Normal).

Abstract (Times New Roman, 10 pt), 3-6 **Keywords** (Times New Roman, 10 pt).

Body of the paper Introduction, Aim of the Study, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusions. The papers are requested to be (Times New Roman, 12 pt, Normal).

References should be indicated in the text by giving the author's name, with the year of publication in parentheses (Haraway, 2016) or (Haraway, 2016, 29).

Bibliography (Times New Roman, 10 pt, Normal).

APA Style should be used

One author:

Author, A. A. (2019). *Title of work*. Location/City, State: Publisher

Two authors:

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (2019). *Title of work*. Location/City, State: Publisher.

More than two authors:

Author, A. A., Author, B. B., & Author, C. C. (2019). *Title of work*. Location/City, State: Publisher.

Post-publication changes are not permitted, so please ensure that your paper has been checked for errors.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE AUTHOR/ AUTHORS

At the end of paper there should be short information about author/authors (up to 100 words per author).
