
Flips and transformative journals











- Health Policy and Planning is registered as a 'Transformative Journal' with Coalition S
- Bioinformatics, ICES Journal of Marine Science, and Europace will flip to OA in 2023




New OUP OA journals

- 19 OA titles launched or joined OUP in 2022, including PNAS Nexus, Policy and Society, Horticulture Research, and Oxford Open Energy
- Four open access journals joining OUP from 2023
- Evolution Letters
- Forensic Sciences Research
- Sexual Medicine
- Protein & Cell
- We expect 6-10 more new OA journals will launch in 2023











Growth of transformative agreements


- We have 29 transformative agreements currently in place
- 23 in Europe
- 3 in Asia
- 2 in North America
- 1 in Australasia
- We are actively negotiating future transformative agreements in Europe, North America, Asia, and South America
- We expect significant growth of transformative agreements over the coming years
- The fastest increase in transformative agreements is still likely to be in Europe, with slower but steady uptake elsewhere








Heal-link publishing, 2020 vs 2021 (Research articles only)










Journals Usage 2021- top ten accounts








Top Ten Journals 2021




