

What are the Benefits of a Transformative Agreement?

Authors publishing in our fully OA journals benefit from the highest global use

- More people see and download the author's work
 - Articles are downloaded over 7000 times on average
- Authors work is read and used more
 - Each article is cited 7.39 times on average the highest of all fully OA publishers
- Authors have the ability to publish in the broadest selection of fully OA journals of all publishers

 Titles appearing cross more JCR categories (139) than any other fully OA journal publisher
- Authors are able to comply with local, national and international funders requirements

 Publishing via the gold OA route in a TA is compliant with many funding bodies including Plan S



TAs support the increase of Gold OA output in all SN Journals disciplines



Hybrid Gold OA share in SN hybrid journals included in DEAL (Excluding Nature subscription journals)

Articles types:

Research Articles = Original Papers, Review Papers, Brief Communications Non-Research Articles = Editorial Notes, Book Reviews, Letters, Reports

Example: 2018/2020

All disciplines in the DEAL agreement see an increase in Gold OA article output.

New routes to OA such as TAs, serve to democratize access.


Example: The number of HSS articles published OA at Springer Nature more than tripled between 2016 and 2020.

Important because OA funding has not been consistent across subject disciplines.

« Reading » Usage also increases

Example – European agreement downloads July 2020-Dec 2021 83% of usage of titles in the Reading List is on <u>subscription</u> content. OA article usage increased by +205% in 18 months



Springer Nature TA's in numbers

Springer Nature's national agreements, alongside its institutional deals, now:

- support researchers from over 2,650 affiliated institutions to publish OA
- Publish an expected **41,400+ OA articles a year**, 10% more than any other publisher.


Our TA's are enabling country level flips to OA

- across the 8 countries with a national TA live in 2019, between 70%-90% of content was published via gold OA
- Sweden, Finland and Poland have seen 89%, 90% and 86% respectively, of Springer Nature content now being published gold OA since the introduction of their Tas
- Conclusion countries with a TA are on a fast track to reaching their OA publishing goals

Global view open access publications by continent


Open access publications support HEAL-Link authors to reach a wider and increasing audience globally

Number of OA Publications between Jul 2020 - Jun 2022: 7,472






Global usage of open access publications by top-using countries Open access publications reach more users and communities independently of their affiliations




70% of the usage of open access publications comes from users that don't necessarily subscribe to Springer Nature content

Springer Nature publishes a market leading portfolio of around 3,000 hybrid and transformative journals

We are the most comprehensive OA research publisher, offering the option to publish OA in all of our journals across all disciplines.

- Portfolio
 - Over **2,200 journals**
 - Over 50 Nature research journals
- Publishing
 - 300,300+ articles were published across our transformative and hybrid journals in 2021
 - Springer Nature was the first publisher to publish 1 million primary research and review articles via gold OA
 - 25% of articles Springer Nature has published since 2005 have been published Gold OA
 - 16% of all OA primary research, has been published by Springer Nature globally, 25% more than any other publisher
 - Content related to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) makes up a greater proportion of OA content than it does of non-OA content - 67% more. SDG research published OA is also downloaded and cited more than non-SDG content published OA
- Reach, Use and Impact
 - **2.5 Million authors** globally across all academic disciplines, have been supported in making their research OA by Springer Nature
 - Since 2016 the research from these titles has collectively been downloaded across the globe, over 2.6billion times even in Antarctica!
