

LIBRARY'S CAMPAIGN IMPROVES SUSTAINABILITY AND DECREASES RESOURCE CONSUMPTION



In 2016, the University College Cork (UCC) Library launched its sustainability campaign, Love Our Library. As a result of actions taken in the campaign's first year, the Library saved over 155,000 KWH - a 9% reduction in energy use. This savings is enough to power a light bulb for 1,770 years or travel around the world 24 times in an electric carl

The UCC, like all public-sector organisations in Ireland, was obliged under the Public-Sector Energy Efficiency Programme to increase efficiency by 33% by the year 2020. A 2016 review identified the UCC Library, the heart of the

Tackling Energy Use

The Buildings & Estates Office in UCC

- · Re-balanced air ventilation and heating systems to improve the office and reading room environmental conditions.
- · Reduced operating times of building services to suit the library occupancy profile.
- · Turned off lights centrally in low occupancy areas during the summer months.

By implementing these changes (at minimum costs) we were able to make energy savings of €20,000 over the course of a six month period. These savings were reinvested in an air barrier at the front entrance to the library, which reduces the amount of cold air entering the building in the winter and warm air in the summer.


We saved 155,000 KWH in 2017, which is equal to a 9% reduction in our energy use. This constitutes enough energy to power a light bulb for 1,770 years or travel around the world 24 times in an electric car!





Τι είναι η Πράσινη Βιβλιοθήκη?

Περιβάλλον είναι ο περιβάλλων χώρος ή οι συνθήκες στις οποίες ζουν και λειτουργούν οι άνθρωποι, οι οργανισμοί, τα ζώα ή τα φυτά. Η έννοια 'περιβάλλον' μπορεί να αναφέρεται στο φυσικό, στο κοινωνικό ή στο πολιπιστικό περιβάλλον.

Βιώσιμη ανάπτυξη είναι η ανάπτυξη που «ανταποκρίνεται στις ανάγκες του παρόντος χωρίς να διακυβεύεται η ικανότητα των μελλοντικών γενεών να καλύψουν τις δικές τους ανάγκες» (Our Common Future, Brundtl and Report, UN).

Τα σημερινά περιβάλλοντα κινδυνεύουν από την κλιματική αλλαγή και άλλες απειλές, συμπεριλαμβανομένων των κοινωνικών ανισοτήτων. Όλοι οι οργανισμοί πρέπει να προσπαθούν να προστατεύσουν το περιβάλλον μέσω της αειφόρου ανάπτυξης. Αυτό περιλαμβάνει όλα τα είδη βιβλιοθηκών, οι οποίες μπορούν να διαδραματίσουν ενεργό και σημαντικό ρόλο στη Βιώσιμη ανάπτυξη.

Μια πράσινη και βιώσιμη βιβλιοθήκη είναι μια βιβλιοθήκη που λαμβάνει υπόψη την περιβαλλοντική, οικονομική και κοινωνική βιωσιμότητα. Οι πράσινες και βιώσιμες βιβλιοθήκες μπορεί να είναι οποιουδήποτε μεγέθους, αλλά θα πρέπει να έχουν ένα σαφές πρόγραμμα βιωσιμότητας που περιλαμβάνει:

- Πράσινα κτίρια και εξοπλισμός: Οι εκπομπές ή το αποτύπωμα άνθρακα του κτιρίου και του εξοπλισμού μειώνονται ενεργά.
- Αρχές «πράσινου γραφείου»: Οι διαδικασίες και λειτουργίες είναι περιβαλλοντικά βιώσιμες
- Βιώσιμη οικονομία: Η κατανάλωση είναι περιορισμένη, οι πρακτικές κυκλικής οικονομίας και οικονομίας διαμοιρασμού προωθούνται και είναι διαθέσιμες στην κοινότητα.
- Βιώσιμες υπηρεσίες βιβλιοθηκών: Σχετική και επικαιροποιημένη πληροφόρηση είναι εύκολα προσβάσιμη στους χρήστες, κοινοί χώροι, συσκευές και περιβαλλοντική εκπαίδευση προσφέρονται και οι διαδικασίες είναι αποτελεσματικές. Η βιβλιοθήκη έχει θετικό αποτύπωμα άνθρακα.
- Κοινωνική βιωσιμότητα: η καλή εκπαίδευση και παιδεία, η δέσμευση στην κοινότητα, η διαπολιτισμική ποικιλομορφία, η κοινωνική συμπερίληψη και εν γένει η συμμετοχικότητα λαμβάνονται υπόψη. Η βιβλιοθήκη εργάζεται ενεργά για να μειώσει την ανισότητα.
- Περιβαλλοντική διαχείριση: Οι περιβαλλοντικοί στόχοι είναι συγκεκριμένοι, μετρήσιμοι, ρεαλιστικοί και χρονικά προσδιορισμένοι και η βιβλιοθήκη εργάζεται να μειώσει τη δική της αρνητική επίδραση στο περιβάλλον. Η περιβαλλοντική πολιτική της βιβλιοθήκης, η εφαρμογή της και τα αποτελέσματα της περιβαλλοντικής δουλειάς διαχέονται σε ένα ευρύτερο κοινό.
- Δέσμευση σε γενικότερους περιβαλλοντικούς σκοπούς και προγράμματα: η δέσμευση καθοδηγείται από τους Στόχους Βιώσιμης Ανάπτυξης του ΟΗΕ, τη Συμφωνία του Παρισιού για την Κλιματική Αλλαγή και σχετικά περιβαλλοντικά πιστοποιητικά και προγράμματα.

REDUCE YOUR WASTE

Be conscious of your trash and think about what you could reuse.

- 2 IMPROVE YOUR PURCHASING
 Consolidate orders, buy in bulk, and eliminate unnecessary orders.
- REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE PAPER Print only when necessary, double-sided, and reuse single-sided pages.
- CONSIDER SPECIALTY WASTE Penn has programs for recycling "e-waste", such as electronics, CFL bulbs, and batteries, as well as ink and toner cartridges, writing instruments, and books.
- 5 LEAVE IT FOR BEN List any used equipment, furniture and supplies on Ben's Attic, before disposing of furniture.
- GO DIGITAL

 Instead of printing, distribute all memos, financial reports, timesheets, and other office communications electronically.
- 7 BYO BOTTLE Take advantage of campus-wide retail discounts and water filters to minimize plastic bottle waste.



The University often uses suppliers with a commitment to social sustainability, e.g. the win gGmbH (cleaning services), the Blindenwerkstatt sheltered workshop (brooms and brushes), the Justizvollzuganstalt Würzburg correctional facility (removals, groundskeeping) or the Mainfränkische Werkstätten sheltered workshop (groundskeeping on Hubland campus).

The 'INklusiv!' programme

The University Library and the Technical Maintenance Service Centre each employ a staff member under the 'INklusiv!' disability employment and inclusion programme. 


