It was founded by Henry VIII in 1534 and has been operating continuously since the first Press book was printed in 1584.

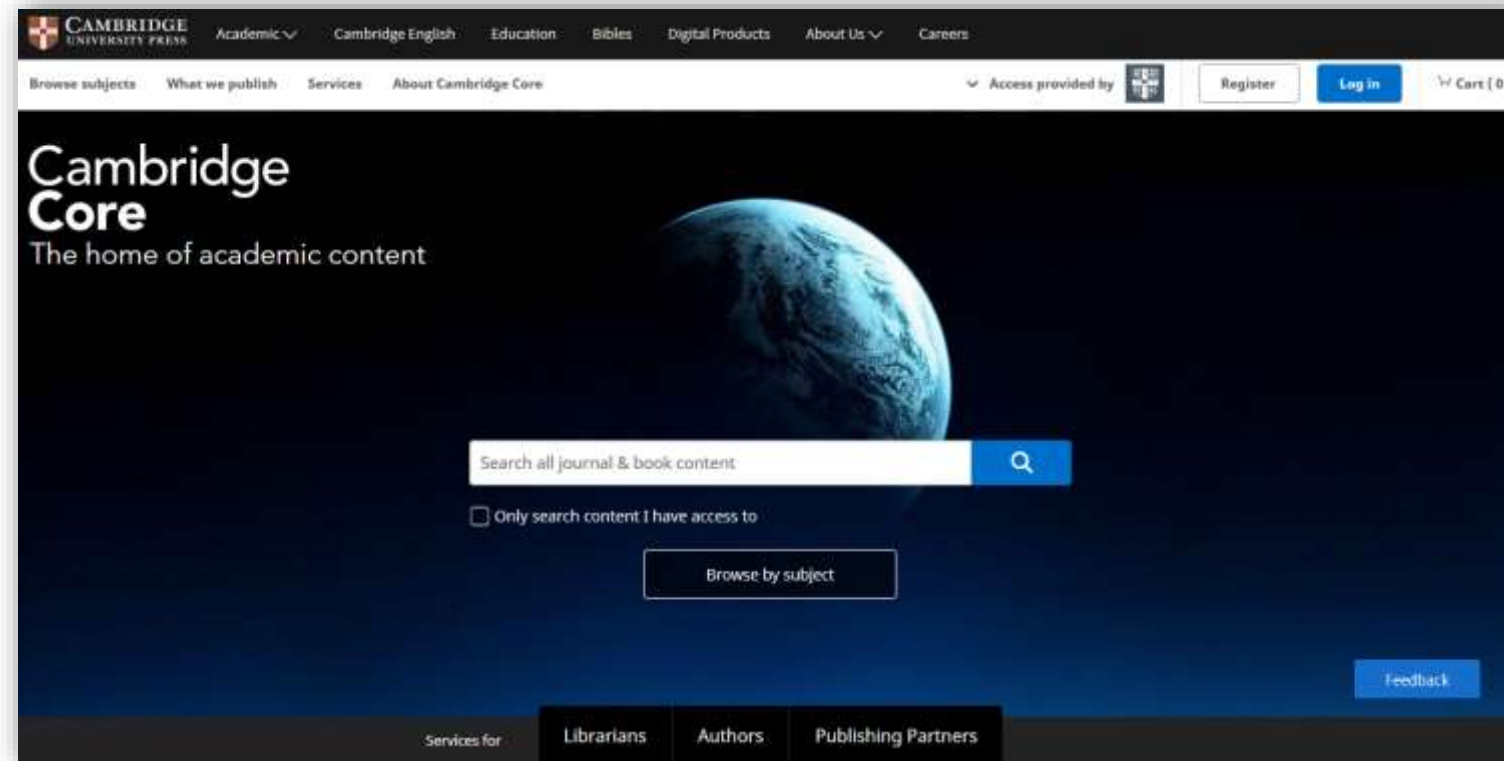
Cambridge University Press furthers the University's mission by disseminating knowledge in the pursuit of education, learning and research at the highest international levels of excellence.

eBook Key Features

- **Perpetual** access purchase

eBook Purchase Model

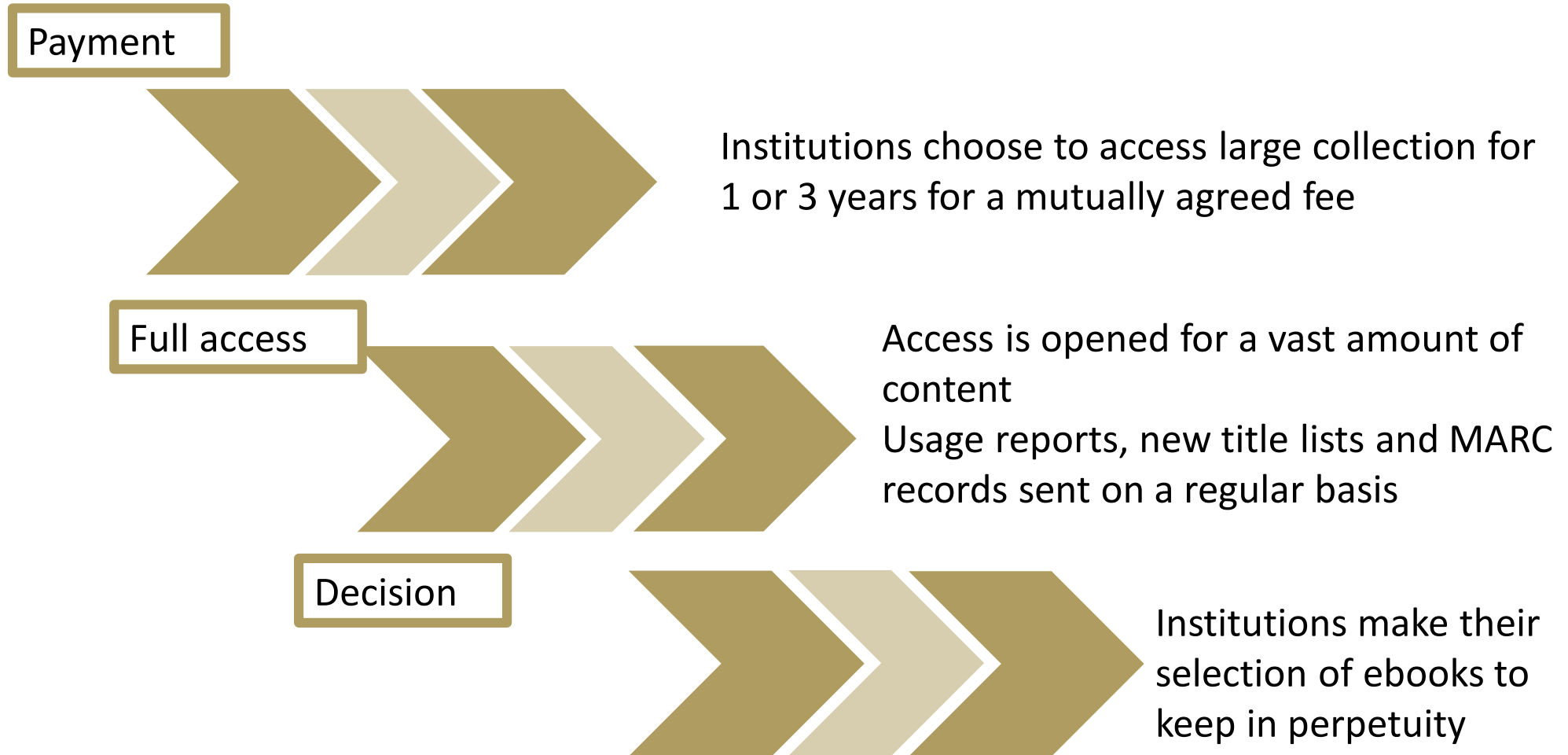
- **Pick and Choose** on a title-by-title-basis, to enable you to buy titles when you need them and build your own bespoke collections
- **Subject collections** select defined subjects of interest (covering more than 30 areas of study) or create your own collections
- **Evidence based Acquisition (EBA)**

Evidence Based Acquisition - What is it?

- The [Cambridge EBA](#) model offers fixed-term **access to a large selection of Cambridge ebooks for a fraction of the list price** (unlimited access/downloads on all content)
- At the end of the EBA period, the institution selects the titles to buy for perpetual access with the help of usage statistics, investing the paid fee

Advantages

- Data-driven decisions; sustainable and wise budget spending
- Both **new titles and back list** immediately **available to all users**
- No access fee
