


Today we will visit the Schoolmuseum which is in Skripero.

Next I will see a big showcase.



Next to the showcase I will see a table with typewriters.



Next to the table with the typewriters I will see a showcase.



Then I will see the last showcases that I will observe up close.



When the tour is over, I will come back to the desks to play.






Next to me there will be a bookcase, a cabinet and an abacus to play with.
