



Social Narrative “History Collection of School and Education” Ionian University’s Museum for visitors on the Autism Spectrum

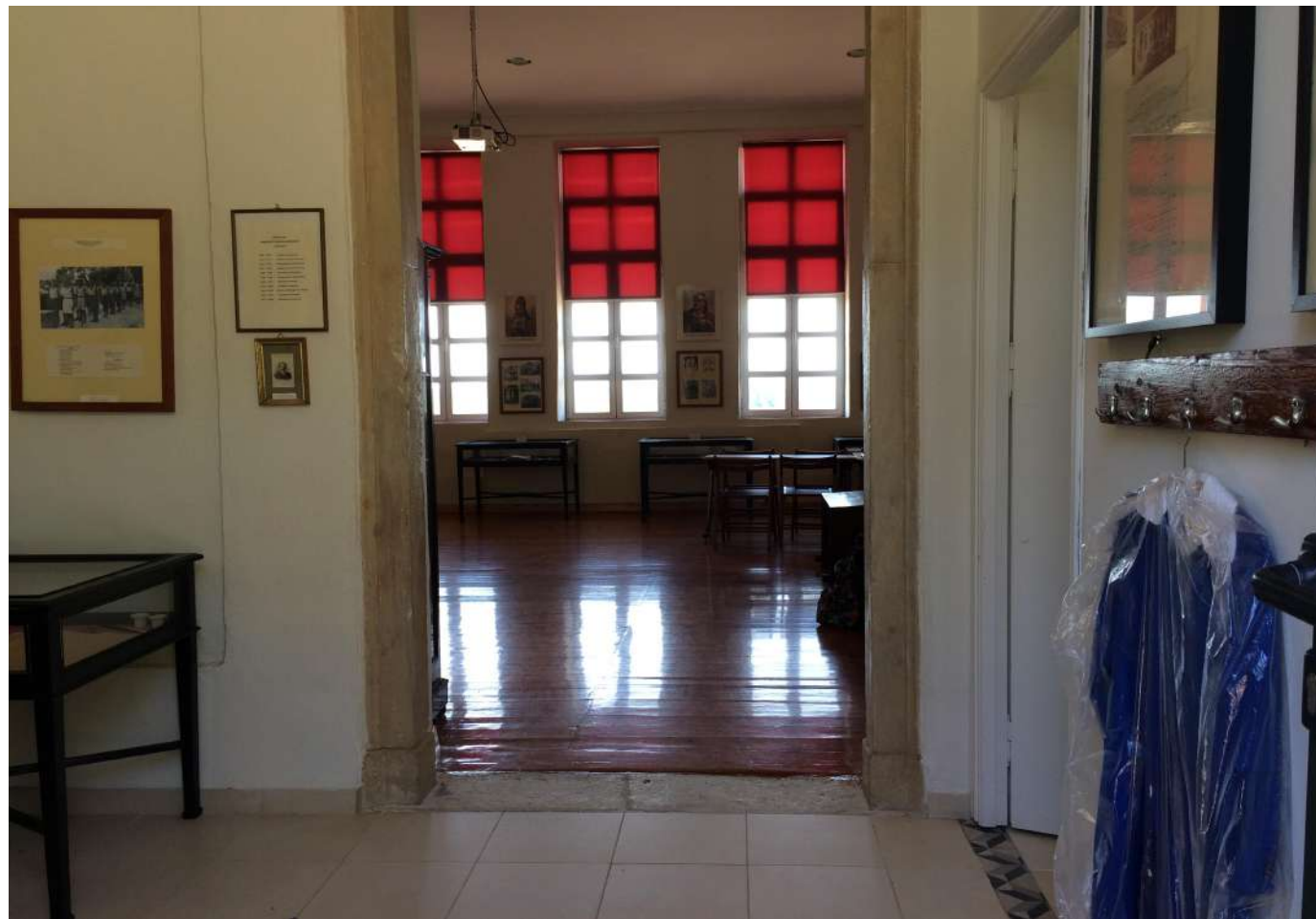


Today we will visit the Schoolmuseum which is in Skripero.

- ✓ I speak in a low voice. I can also use my inner voice.

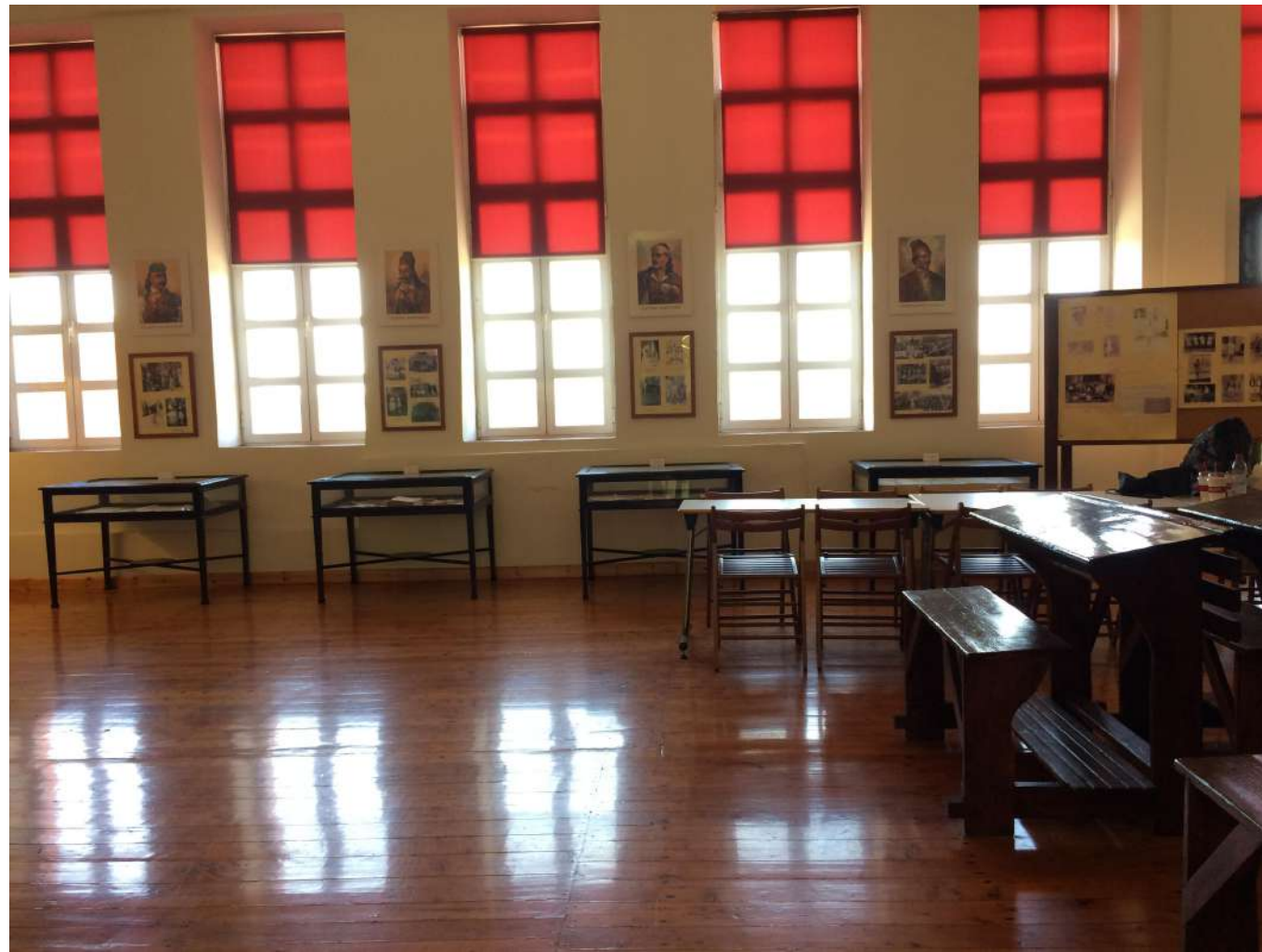
I remember the rules so everyone is happy!

After I will see the board and the pictures around it.



Next to the board I will see a showcase with tools for experiments and the door for the yard.

Next to the table with the typewriters I will see a showcase.



Then I will see the last showcases that I will observe up close.
