



- Clarify exactly what the contribution/usefulness to science and originality of the proposed thesis lies. (200-400 words)
- 3) Explain the main aims and proposals of your paper. (200-400 words)
- 4) Specify the research methodology you intend to use. Justify its suitability for the objectives/assumptions of your work. (500-900 words)
- 5) Determine the expected duration of the main tasks/stages of the thesis, such as e.g. literature review, collection and processing of research material, conducting experiments or scenarios, designing software, submitting a detailed writing plan, writing the chapters/parts of the thesis. (preferably but not necessarily in the form of a Gantt chart , like the example below)
- Specify the degree of maturity of the proposed thesis (eg previous relevant scientific work/research/applications or professional activities, if any). (200-400 words)
- Clarify the relevance of the proposed topic to the subject and the overall academic (research, writing and teaching) work of the supervising professor. (200-400 words)
- 8) Bibliographic references that appear in the proposal.
