### Hourly Loans Functionality

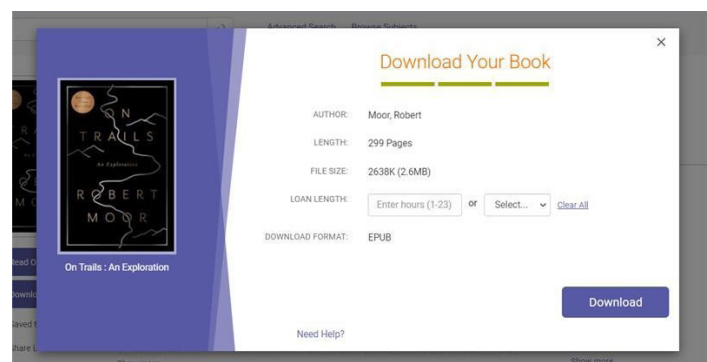

When enabled, patrons will have the option to select between 1-23 hours OR daily when downloading ebooks for offline reading. There is no limit to the number of times a student can download a book – only the number of hours the student can access the downloaded book.

What's New in Rialto:

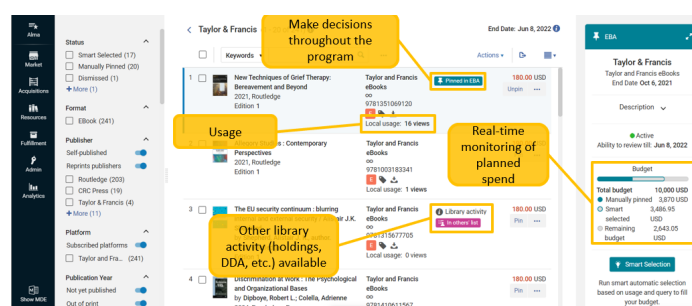
