### The Museum

The Ionian University is the only higher institution in Greece that has created its own museum as a central structure covering all its departments, under the name Museum Collections of the Ionian University (Government Gazette 144/29.01.2019/v.B). In this way, it incorporated in its operation an institution, the University Museum, which was founded in Europe since the 17th century.

A key parameter of our museum policy is the participatory approach that is considered necessary to transform the museum into an organization that is actively involved in the life of the university community and the urban fabric, interested in creating permanent links with it.





#### **TYPOGRAPHY**

Through machines, tools and objects for the production of printed and archival material, older document production technologies and the origins of modern digital media are highlighted.

#### HISTORY OF SCHOOL & EDUCATION

In a school building of the early 20th century in Skripero in northern Corfu, archival material and objects related to the school's functions during the 20th century are presented and highlighted, as well as the representation of an authentic classroom of earlier times.

#### **DIGITAL CULTURE & ARTS**

Through the Museum's official website, virtual reality creations with three-dimensional (3D) modelling, 3D design objects and documents, as well as new artistic forms of audiovisual expression and processing of sound and image are presented.

### **ADMINISTRATION**

Towards drafting of the Government Gazette, research was carried out on the administrative structure of university museums in Greece. A format was chosen that follows a basic model, following the laboratory format, enriched with the innovation of the institutional structure to meet the needs of the university in general. The project also includes the development of a web platform where users can create their own customized guided tours and interactive storytelling.





# Study aiming at the conversion of an existing building into the Digital Museum of Itea - Municipality of Delphi

The Museum of the Ionian University collaborates with the Municipality of Delphi with the aim of transforming the current building of the Conservatory into a Digital Museum of Itea. Greece. Using new technologies, visitors will be able to explore the history and cultural heritage of Itea through interactive exhibits. The museum offers two classifications: chronological and thematic, allowing visitors to choose the route they prefer. Each exhibit is accompanied by written and audio documentation, as well as visual material such as photographs and maps.

The museum will offer a variety of experiences, prompting the visitors to navigate chronologically and thematically through space and time.


