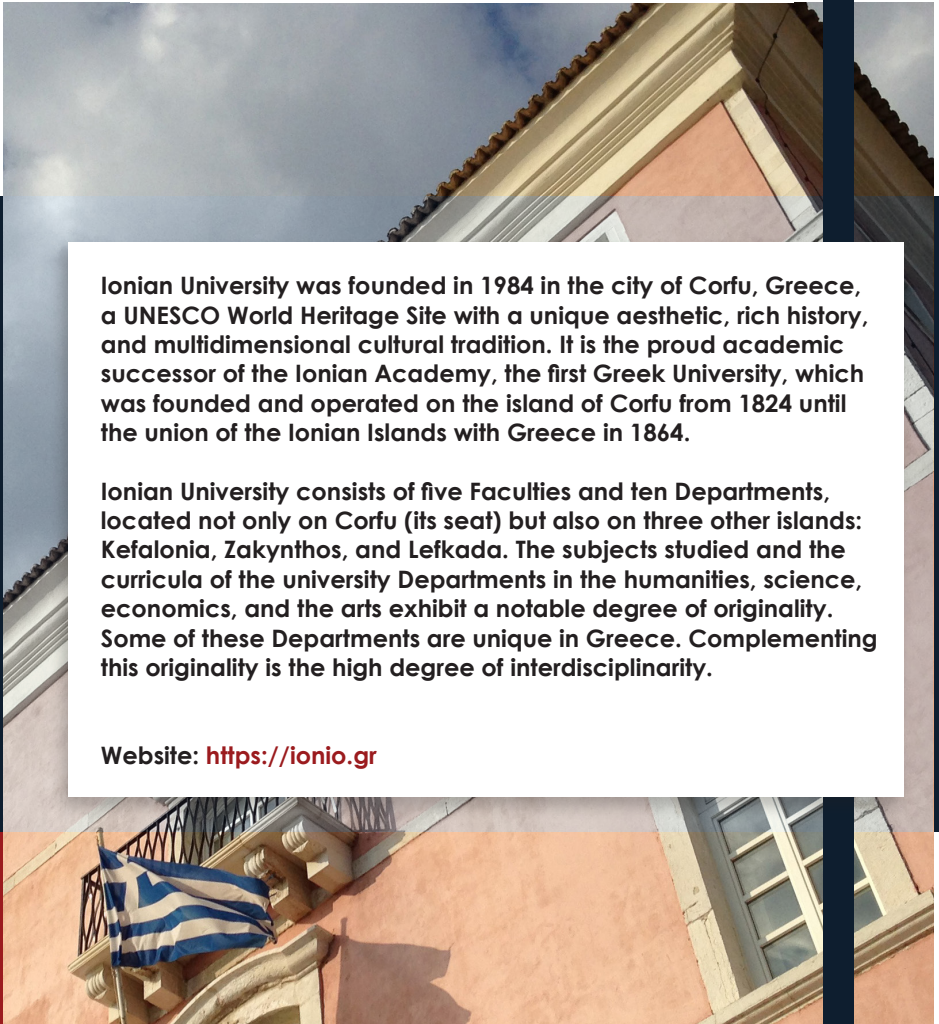


Ionian University

Ionian University was founded in 1984 in the city of Corfu, Greece, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with a unique aesthetic, rich history, and multidimensional cultural tradition. It is the proud academic successor of the Ionian Academy, the first Greek University, which was founded and operated on the island of Corfu from 1824 until the union of the Ionian Islands with Greece in 1864.

Ionian University consists of five Faculties and ten Departments, located not only on Corfu (its seat) but also on three other islands: Kefalonia, Zakynthos, and Lefkada. The subjects studied and the curricula of the university Departments in the humanities, science, economics, and the arts exhibit a notable degree of originality. Some of these Departments are unique in Greece. Complementing this originality is the high degree of interdisciplinarity.

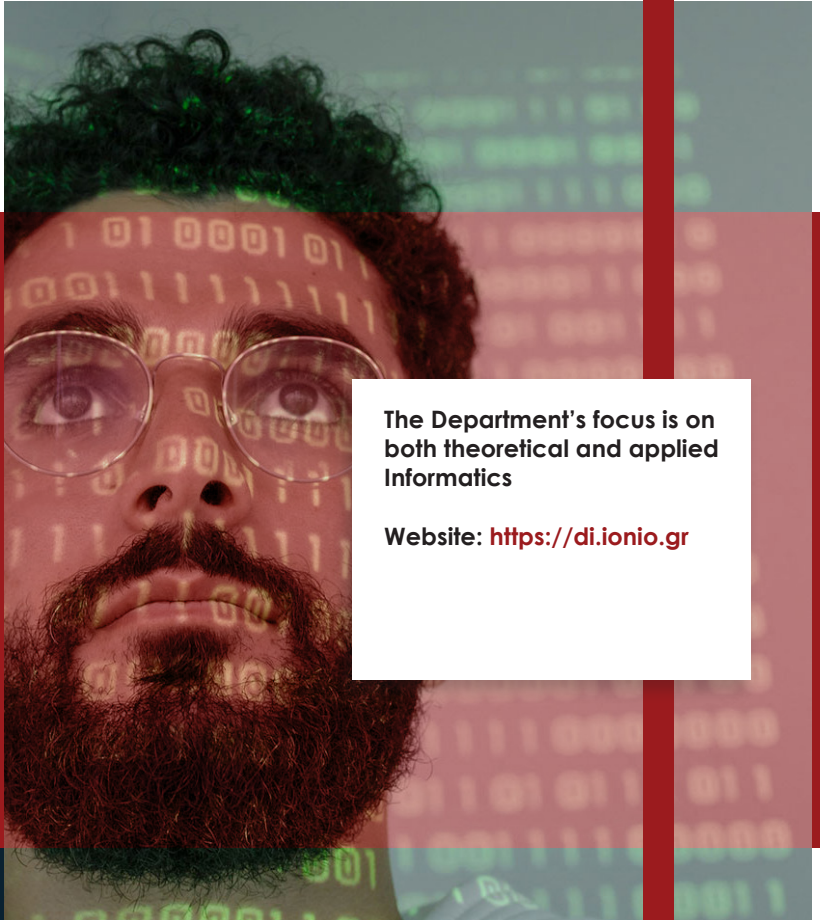
Department of Archives, Library Science and Museology




