Requirements for the application:

1. ERASMUS Application form with photo

3. Curriculum vitae
4. Recording, links are preferred: 3 pieces of 3 epochs, about 15 minutes altogether
5. **knowledge of the German language (B2 minimum).**

You can send in your application in paper form (with CD) or as an e-mail (with links), no files please.

Courses and Lessons: As an ERASMUS student you get individual lessons in one instrument (normally 1 hour per week, normally 15 ECTS credits per semester). For all other subjects you can take part in all classes and courses you are interested in. You are free, there is no fixed schedule. You can choose what you want or need. But you are NOT entitled to get individual lessons for a second instrument. Normally a semester is up to 30 ECTS credits, to do more is not possible. The number of credits in most subjects depends on your work load (i.e. number of private rehearsal hours, number of concerts and performances and so on), therefore the ECTS credits are confirmed by your teacher at the end of your exchange study. ERASMUS students are NOT allowed to any kind of examinations. Language: All lessons and courses are given in German language. So you must have some knowledge of the German language (B2).
