Call for Workshops

TRANSLATA V INTERFACES IN TRANSLATION

19th–21st September 2024

The 5th edition of TRANSLATA, the conference series of the Department of Translation Studies of the University of Innsbruck, will take place in Innsbruck, Austria from the 19th–21st September 2024. The overall theme of this edition of TRANSLATA is *Interfaces in Translation*.

This year, TRANSLATA takes the format of a conference comprising individual thematic workshops organised and headed by various workshop leaders. There is also a general section to which all other presentations will be assigned. Within the workshops and the general section, presentations are scheduled for 30 minutes (20 minutes for presentation and 10 minutes for discussion). With this circular, we would like to invite all interested colleagues to apply to lead a workshop by the 8th of March 2024. The thematic foci for the workshops are intentionally broad in scope. Prospective workshop leaders are welcome to propose topics on all types of translation, theoretical and applied aspects of translation, in addition to diverse translation studies paradigms. Please send us the following information about your proposed workshop:

- Title of the workshop
- Topic and short description of the workshop (max. 400 words) in German and English
- Envisaged scope of the workshop (planned number of contributions)
- Languages of workshop contributions
- Name and contact details of the workshop leaders

At the request of workshop leaders, some presentations can be held online. Workshop leaders are responsible for organising the workshops and reviewing the submitted abstracts. However, the organising team reserves the right to assign thematically suitable papers submitted to the general section to individual workshops in agreement with the workshop leaders. Workshop leaders are also requested to forward contributions that cannot be considered because of the language of the presentation to the organisers of the general section.

The conference organisation team will take care of all organisational matters prior to and during the conference. Notification of acceptance of proposed workshops will be given by the 22nd of March 2024. The list of planned workshops will be published in the second circular in March 2024, and registration for contributors will be opened shortly afterwards. The preliminary workshop programme must be submitted to the conference organisation by the 30th of June 2024 and will be published on the conference website shortly afterwards. The application period for presentations for the general section is also open between the 1st of April 2024 and the 30th of June 2024.

Since its foundation, TRANSLATA has striven to promote multilingualism in its conference editions. Therefore, contributions can be submitted in all languages taught at our department (German, English, French, Italian, Russian and Spanish). Furthermore, we seek to promote German as a language of science in our field of research.

The conference fees are as follows:

• Regular fee: €80

• Early bird fee (to be paid by 15th of July 2024): €50

• Student fee: €25

• Audience/participants from Innsbruck University: no fee

The conference fee includes refreshments during breaks (coffee/tea, juice, biscuits), leisure programme (city tour or similar), and conference proceedings (with chapters by contributors). The workshop leaders are exempt from conference fees (irrespective of their presence on site at the time of the conference).

We look forward to welcoming you to Innsbruck in September 2024.
