- ✓ Bachelor's degree in the field of Humanities or in Archaeological Sciences, with high grade average, preferably upper-second (B+).
- ✓ Proficiency in English (C2 level), in case English is not candidate's native language
- ✓ Certification of computer skills

- **Second semester:** Choose one of the three partner institutes to continue your studies
- **Summer Period:** Participate for one month in one or more field research project offered
- **Third Semester:** Decide which of the three partner institutes will host your thesis journey

- ◆ **Field Project:** Field Research, 1 Select Module
- ◆ **Master Dissertation**
